### Architecture

(July) Dick Spring reported three approvals since the last meeting. Dick had several items that the Committee asked him to bring before the Board:

- (1) The Committee would like to have the authority to decide architectural rulings and the Board would support their decisions. Board of Directors said No.
- (2) The Committee requested guidance on what "earth tone" colors are. Board discussion brought out that blue is out, gray is okay, brown and beige are okay. Dick Spring will get color samples from Sherwin Williams. Connie mentioned that John Massey of J & J Painting has the original colors for Lake Christopher homes. Dick Spring will make up chart of approved color ranges, Board will approve ranges.

## Zoning

(July) Mary Broom talked about the farm behind Lake Christopher. Nothing has been posted yet. Dick heard they were going up for zoning one more time, but nothing yet. Mary asked to be kept posted if anyone sees anything.

(August) General discussion on situation on rezoning farmland adjacent to Shorebreeze & Lake Christopher Drive. No specific rezoning actions at present from owners.

### Newsletter

(July) Inputs for next newsletter need to be to Donna Christenson by August 10. Newsletter will come out around the third week of August. June issue was Frannie Bostich's last newsletter. She recommended that the Board stay with publishing the newsletter every other month - has been working well. Board doesn't want "storefront businesses" advertised in newsletter. Ads should be run by Board before publishing.

(August) Articles due to Professional Property Managers, Inc., by August 15. Professional Property Managers, Inc., will print newsletter.

### Security Report

(August) Bob Contrell said our two guards are doing a good job on patrolling common areas.

### Maintenance

(July) Board discussed putting water pumps in the big park. The other two smaller parks are being watered by homeowners. Also discussed putting two lights at the big park to curb after-dark activities. Security Guard postion could be expanded to rake sand on beaches each morning, etc. Will be brought to Bob's attention. Also need to get better quality sand at the beaches. Present sand stains your clothes.

Lawn Service: The Service had recommended we wait on mulching, but received so many complaints that he went ahead and mulched. Weed killer hasn't had time to kill everything and has come back through the mulch. Service needs \$129/month more to break even. Dick Montgomery recommended we pay half (\$62.50)/month, and he would suffer the rest of the loss. Duncan Bell will be liaison from now on with Lawn Service. Dick Spring wants it to be brought to his attention to "fall seed" after September 15. Consensus was if he performs well, then we'll go full extra amount. Dick Spring moved we pay an additional \$129/month starting August 1 (for work in July) at the end of the month. Mary Broom seconded. Board approved.

(August) Reported continued trouble with one of the boys being paid for clean-up of common areas. He was not doing required work. Motion was made, seconded, and approved to "terminate David Marino per procedures in the contract.

# Sale of Land

(July) Selling the Property Across from the Ballfield: Bill Van Hoy said that we may not be able to rezone ballfield. Required to have so much common area per home lots. Need to get engineer to do preliminary work. Directed to call Talbot & Associates they did original surveys, to see if this can be done. Bill will take care of this. Connie asked if field could be fenced off, fixed up, and made usable. Bill said there are several ideas the Board can look at.

(August) Talbot & Associates (surveyors) said we have 2 large building lots in the land across Lynnhaven Blvd. from the ballfield. They charge \$650.00 to lay out the subdivision plat and file it with the city. Bob Kirkland (Professional Property Managers, Inc.) has advised us to hold off that step until he can determine if the city has some property it wants to swap. A swap would give us land we can sell without changing the Covenants.

## Hospitality Report

(August) Reported visits by committee members to new residents. The committee in need of rep from Shorebreeze Court. In connection with hospitality, Professional Property Managers, Inc., rep read letter that would be mailed to all Realtors.
